NONSTANDARD ADMINISTRATION OF ISEE TEST

Special accommodations for students with a documented physical challenge or learning differences is offered only on December 6, 2008 at Villa Duchesne and Oak Hill School for Grades 7th-12th and only on February 7, 2009 at Chaminade College Preparatory School for Grades 5th and 6th.

Independent School Entrance Examination (ISEE) test booklets (both the Online Guide and the Student Guide) are available at ISSL member schools. The ISEE:

1. test can be taken only once within a six-month period and not for practice;
2. test can be taken at several locations – the test location has no bearing on the admission process at a family's school of choice;
3. results can be sent to multiple schools;
4. registration must be completed at least three weeks in advance of the test date.

If a student is a walk-in registrant, please have registration form, payment and any other required information completed and available for check-in at test site.

Answers to Frequently Asked Questions

- Parents may register by mail, phone, fax, or online at www.iseetest.org.
- The time of the test and check-in time are listed on a Verification Letter, which families will receive in the mail once the registration has been processed.
- The test takes approximately three hours not including test directions and breaks.
- In addition to the Verification Letter, students need to bring four sharpened #2 pencils, with erasers, two black or blue ballpoint pens and NO OTHER materials - no calculators, books or rulers.
- Parents receive a copy of the test scores within two weeks.
